The WHO is attempting a global coup

IT'S TIME TO ACT, THERE IS STILL TIME

The WHO is moving on several fronts and aspires to become the world government for health emergencies.

- 1) **The so-called "Pandemic Treaty" (WHO CA+)** is not a treaty, but a framework convention that aims at the creation of a bureaucratic apparatus the COP (Conference of the Parties) will be given carte blanche on future protocols and on the management of future health emergencies.
 - In the COP private cartels (foundations, BigPharma and financial institutions) will sit on an equal basis with states in "decision making".

- 2) **The 307 proposed amendments to the International Health Regulations (2005) (RIS)** are currently being discussed in complete secrecy. If adopted there will be:
 - Extensive transfer of power to the WHO. ● Loss of individual rights in health matters is an advancement of "Community" (i.e. communitarian) law.
 - Centralization of supply and logistics in future health emergencies.
 - Creation and management of a (other) Fund linked to principles of "equity", i.e. yet another hoarding of private banking cartels.
